ADMISSIONS - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Does UCDH have an application deadline?

No, UCDH does not have an application deadline. Applications are accepted until the incoming class is full including alternates.

Does UCDH report the number of applications they receive?

No, UCDH does not release numbers on the applications that we receive. We accept 60 students into each cohort.

How should I send my transcripts (high school and college)?

All official transcripts must be sent directly from the school from which they are requested. Transcripts must be official to be applied toward prerequisite transfer credit.

<u>Electronic Transcripts</u>: Official electronic transcripts may be submitted through the following approved platforms: Parchment/Naviance, eScrip-Safe, Scribbles, or National Student Clearinghouse. If prompted to include a recipient email address, please use <u>transcripts@ucdh.edu</u>.

The Utah College of Dental Hygiene reserves the right to request a hard copy mailed transcript.

Will my prerequisite transfer to UCDH?

The best way to find out if your classes will transfer as prerequisite courses is to arrange to have your transcripts sent to UCDH. The Admissions Office can review your transcripts for transfer credits. After your transcripts have been sent, contact the Admissions Office by phone (801)426-8234 or email admissions@ucdh.edu and they can tell you what will transfer, what you still need to complete, etc.

When does the program start?

UCDH rotates starting dates. We start accepting applications 12 months prior to each class start date.

What is the typical class schedule?

Classes during the BSDH program are full-time. Typically held Monday-Thursday. Classes may be held on select Fridays due to holidays or unforeseen events. The program is 20 months long.

Does UCDH offer an associate degree?

No, UCDH offers only a Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene.

Do all my prerequisites need to be completed to apply to UCDH?

No, there is no reason to delay applying, since your prerequisites do not have to be completed before you apply; they must only be completed before the program begins.
